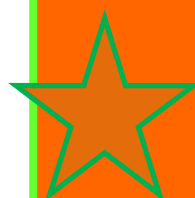

PERSISTENT ABSENCE

Since the start of the 2015/16 academic year, a pupil has been classified as a **persistent absentee** if they miss 10 per cent or more of their own possible sessions.

Over the next few weeks, our Attendance Officer will arrange to meet with the parents of children who are in danger of reaching the persistent absence threshold by the end of the year.

Letters will be sent to families where their child's attendance already places them as a persistent absentee.

Fines may be implemented where attendance is avoidably low.
