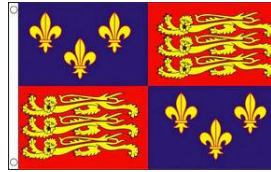

This year our "Bug" theme is countries of the world and there is a whole new set of bugs to collect.

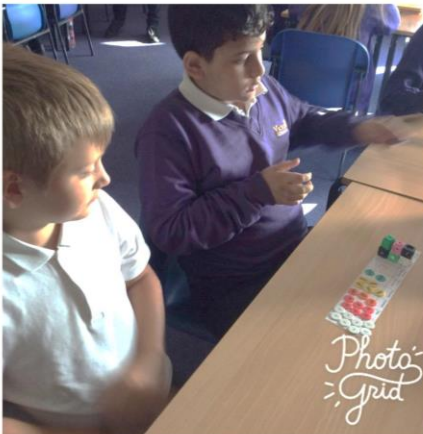
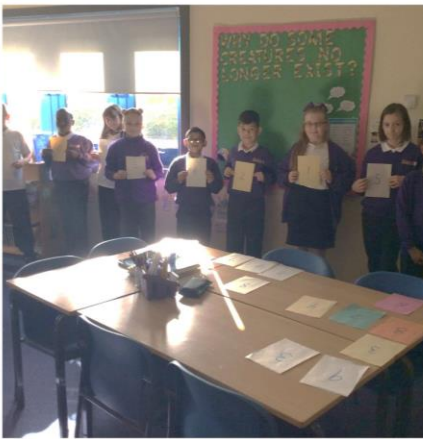
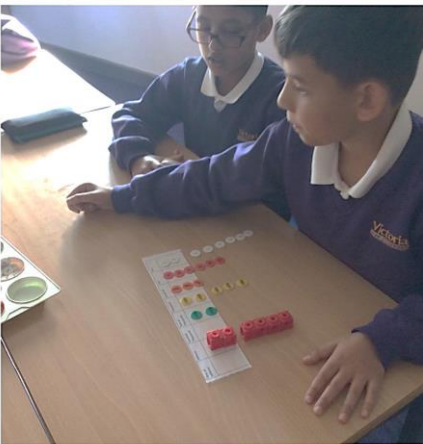
Look out for details on the attendance notice board in the library.
