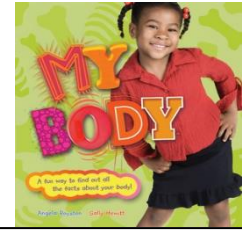




## Our Year 1 Term 1 2015 Family Learning Journey

#### Learning overview

In phonic lessons this term the children will be learning new sounds, consolidating prior learning and using sounds learnt to write words and sentences. We will be using our phonic knowledge in other subjects to label, write captions, read and evaluate toys and work.

In Mathematics this term we will be using numicon and other resources to count and order numbers to 30. We will be counting objects accurately, continuing and making patterns as well as adding to find the total of 2 groups and subtracting to find the difference.

In RE this term the children will be looking at people who are inspirational and why people feel that they are inspirational.

In our Connected Curriculum we will be looking at our senses and using these to explore different things in our environment. We will be investigating baby toys and what makes them good and bad, as well as looking at old and new toys and how they have changed
