

Our Year 4 Term 2 2016 Learning Journey is:

How we see, how we hear.

This term in Year 4 we are learning about how we see and hear, along with continuing to practise for our forthcoming Christmas concert!

Learning Overview

We will be working this term on a Science focus by learning all about the sound and light.

We will learn about light and sound sources, how our eyes and ears work and how shadows are formed.

We will investigate the Sun as a light source and how we can use it to tell the time. We will also learn about the effects of the Sun's rays and how we can be safe when studying the Sun. In Art we will be producing silhouette paintings and then finally this term we will be investigating how we can insulate sound.

In English we will be continuing our work on poetry and poetic techniques and then moving onto reading and writing journalistic recounts.

In Maths we have begun working on using the Singapore bar method when solving problems.



Please ensure that your child comes to school each day wearing correct uniform. This includes **black shoes**. Children are not allowed to wear jewellery to school - watches and stud earrings are acceptable. The children should not be wearing bracelets or charity bands.

It is a requirement for all children to take part in PE. They must have a complete change of clothes - **purple t-shirt, black shorts or jogging bottoms**. They should also have a change of shoes.

Our PE days are Wednesdays and Fridays- it is easiest though if children leave their PE kits in school for the term.
